We will have an afternoon drive/ walk. Following the theme of our Church at Easter, 'Lest we Forget' this year we will visit the house of Hedd Wyn, near Trawsfynydd. Hedd Wyn was a Welsh-language poet who was killed on the first day of the Battle of Passchendaele. He was posthumously awarded the bard's chair at the 1917 National Eisteddfod. The Snowdonia National Park Authority have purchased the property, and is now opened as a museum in remembrance of his 1st World War service. (Please note our published booklet, *The 1<sup>st</sup> World War, a Great War?* is still available £3 95, post free, from Harvey). Tea will be taken in a suitable venue, which will be chosen because of its supply of cream teas!
