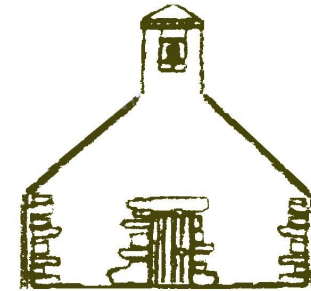

Mai/May:
